Background of Green IT

- With economic growth, establishing information societies is leading to increase IT device/systems power consumption rapidly.
 - → Data traffic on the Internet will be 100 to 200 times greater in 2025. IT power consumption is estimated to grow 5-10 fold in 2025 than that of today.
- Effective use of IT (Green IT) greatly helps
 reducing society's energy consumption: 2% vs 98%
 - → IT and electronics technologies is expected to generate greater productivity in all economic and social activities, boosting efficiency in production, logistics, administration and even IT use itself.

Why Green IT should be accelerated in Thailand

- 1. Thailand is already a world production and service center, being expected to sustain. growth into the future by using Green IT.
- 2. <u>Green IT</u> will reduce cost! (= strengthen competitiveness of industries)
- 3. Green IT resolves global warming as a key challenge.



 - Overseas Training Programs: 94courses / 3,714 participants








